During the evening of September 9th, or early morning of September 10th, unknown person or persons attempted to break into a Type 9 magazine used to store seismic explosives on a program located near Cremona, Alberta. Fortunately, the attempt was unsuccessful and no product was stolen. The attempted break-in was discovered by the drill push upon his arrival at the magazine site in the morning of September 10th. Also missing at the same time were two MRX boxes from the vicinity of the magazine site, and these two events are presumed to be related. All CAGC members should ensure that they are diligent in their security arrangements in regards to explosive storage in light of this incident.
